### COMCAST FIBER OPTIC CABLE

WE have 10 homes who have still not connected to Comcast Fiber Optic cable. Comcast requires ALL homes to be connected, even if they do not subscribe to Comcast before they can let our community have full fiber optic advantage. Two have already made appointments and if you are one of the 8 please call 1-800-comcast (1800-266-2278) and ask them to install. There is no charge for this service.

### OUR LAKES & RECLAIMED WATER

You may have noticed that our lakes are low. This is typical during the dry season. Our rainy season starts May 20, so we can expect more shoreline to be visible until then. The lakes are being fed with reclaimed water from Palm Beach Water Utilities, which distributes 15 Million gallons per day to golf courses and communities from their facility on Hagen Ranch Rd. Aberdeen supplies our lake water to us thru a system of pipes. If you see purple pipes along the roadways, that's reclaimed water.

### PALM TREE DISEASE

We may be having a big problem with some of our palm trees. There is a disease affecting some types of palm trees called Red Palm Weevil Disease. Bugaway will start soon to spray any infected Palms with a chemical called Safari. Please check the palm trees on your property and if you notice anything unusual please report it to our web site so we can monitor the problem.
