REMEMBER THESE DATES

In January, Campbell Property Management mailed to all Bristol Lakes residents, its first notice informing us of our Annual Meeting, scheduled for: **March 21, 2019 @ 6:30 pm** at the Boynton Beach Library on Jog Road.

Included with that mailing, was a "NOTICE OF INTENT FORM" to be used to place YOUR name on the ballot for the Bristol Lakes HOA 2019 Election of Directors.

If you would like to serve on the Board of Directors, the **DEADLINE** to complete the form and return it to Campbell Property Management at the address listed on their letter, is **February 15, 2019**. When it is received, Campbell Property Management will ask you, as an interested candidate, to submit a resume. When they mail their second notice, resumes, as well as other pertinent information relating to the Annual Meeting will be included.

WATER CONSERVATION IS A YEAR-AROUND THING

Although we do not currently have any "Water Alerts" issued by our Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD), there is always a possibility of a water shortage in South Florida, including Palm Beach County. As of January 15, 2019, the South Florida Water Management District was still proactively planning for any potential water shortage conditions, and will continue to monitor the situation. Year-round water restrictions on landscape watering are still in force for all of South Florida, and our LWDD follows those recommendations. One or two good rainfalls, such as we have had this past week, have helped, but will not completely eradicate any drought conditions that currently exist. This dry season, which started last November, has been a drier one than average. There are even parts of Eastern Palm Beach County that are 45% below the average seasonal rainfall amounts.

Year-round water conservation should be on everyone's "To-Do" List. Our water is one of our most precious resources. We cannot afford to squander it. Please conserve your water usage whenever possible. Of course, more rain will help mitigate our dry conditions, but we can also do our part to help, as well.

POWER WASHING OF SIDEWALKS AND SWALES
