SPEEDING ON GEORGETOWN And Throughout the Community

We point out Georgetown Lane because of its blind curve and limited visibility. Our request for the Palm Beach Sheriffs Office to patrol our roads, that was submitted last year has not been authorized yet. We needed to submit the necessary documents again because PBSO changed the form. The new time frame is October or November. We ask ALL residents to observe our speed limits of 20MPH and to remind your contractors and delivery personnel to do the same. We are a small community with lots of pedestrians and children playing.

WATER MANAGEMENT

The threat of a tropical storm this weekend, with the possibility of us receiving a lot of rain, is just a reminder, that all of our weirs (control structures) have automatic run offs. Once the lakes reach a certain level, the water automatically runs out to the canals. We only have one weir that can be opened. Lake Worth Drainage and South Florida Water Management are closely monitoring the water levels.

HURRICANES and SHUTTERS

According to the Documents Hurricane Shutters may be installed when the National Weather Service issues a hurricane weather watch. They must be removed 5 days after the storm passes.

ARC APPROVALS

The question keeps coming up, "do I need an Approval"? YES, for any job that requires work to be done outside your home you may require an approval. Read the requirements from the web site. If you are doing work inside your home you do not need ARC approval, or if you are replacing existing items such as plants you do not, but if you are adding or subtracting plants or trees yes, you may need approval. To be safe, if there is a question, submit an ARC request.

LEASH AND PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG

All dogs must be on a leash when off your property. This includes Emotional Support animals and Service animals. Bristol Lakes is a very pet friendly Community and we want to keep it that way.

GOLF CARTS MUST BE REGISTERED

Since September of 2015, Bristol Lakes has required registration of Golf Carts that are used on our roadways. Also required is a Certificate of Insurance with the clause, ("Golf cart is insured for liability and operating within the community of Bristol Lakes HOA).
