DRIVE SAFE

CURB APPEAL

Nothing looks worse than debris at the curb, other than on garbage pick up day. Our by-laws are VERY clear on what and when items can be put to the curb. For those who "forgot" here is the schedule. Wednesday = garbage and yard waste ; Saturday = Garbage, recycles and bulk waste. Bugaway does drag fronds to the curb on days they are here, but removes them that day. Please keep yard waste by the side of your home until after 5 on Tuesday.

KNOW YOUR DOCUMENTS

Each Month we will be publishing 1 item from our Declaration Of Covenants And Restrictions Of Bristol Lakes At Aberdeen. The whole document can be found on our web site www.bristollakes.com

6.6 Garbage and Trash Each OWNER shall regularly pick up garbage, trash, refuse or rubbish on the OWNER'S LOT, and no OWNER or resident shall place or dump any garbage, trash, refuse, or other materials on any portions of the SUBJECT PROPERTY including any COMMON AREA, or any property contiguous to the SUBJECT PROPERTY, Garbage, trash refuse or rubbish that is required to be placed at the front of the LOT in order to be collected may be placed and kept at the front of the LOT after 5: p.m. on the day before the scheduled day of the collection, and any trash facilities must be removed on the collection day. All garbage, trash, refuse or rubbish must be placed in appropriate trash facilities or bags. All containers, dumpsters or garbage facilities shall get stored inside a UNIT or fenced in area and screened from view and kept in a clean and sanitary condition. No noxious or offensive odors shall be permitted.

Simply Stated

Tuesday after 5PM the grey can and yard waste piled neatly at the curb. Pile the yard waste by the side of the house until Tuesday night.

Friday after 5PM The grey can and recyclable bins plus bulk items (grill, construction material, furniture, etc.) Piled neatly up to 6 cubic Yards (3 refrigerators on the side = roughly 6 cu yds)

- 11/09 START MULCH
- 11/10-11 L&O PEST/RODENT/ FIRE ANT, TURF WEED CONTROL
- 11/12 CUT, EDGE STREETS, DRIVES AND WALKS
- 11/19 CUT, EDGE STREETS, DRIVES AND WALKSSUBJECT TO CHANGE DUE TO WEATHER
