We also have license plate readers that can pick up a plate number in the dark. We have the ability to identify offenders by their plate information from the PBSO, so we can bring up charges for damages.

- 9/24 Cut, Edge Streets, Drives and Walks

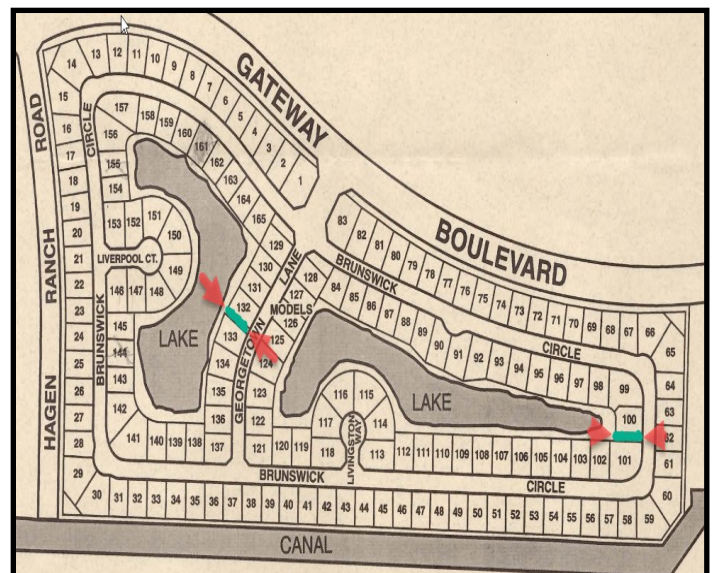
MEET YOUR NEW MAIL PERSON
